USB 2.0 to RJ45 Fast Ethernet Adapter

Installation Instructions

- 1) Connect the Adapter to a USB computer port and check that the blue LED is lit.
- 2) Connect an Ethernet patch cable to a router or LAN.
- 3) Check the documentation of your router to configure network access.

Notes: Green LED indicates a live network connection

Yellow LED indicates data transfer status

Troubleshooting Tips

- Reboot your computer and router
- Check that the LEDs are lit
- Configure the Adapter with a static IP address, if required.
- Test by turning off all wireless functions
- Test the Ethernet patch cable with another computer
- Try a different USB port or computer
- Verify that your computer recognizes the Adapter:

Windows: Control Panel>Device Manager>Network adapters>Realtek USB

macOS: Apple Menu>System Preferences>Network>USB 10/100 LAN
